The Alaska Native age-adjusted rate of death from preventable chronic diseases ran 1.4 to 2.1 times that of their White peers

Some analysts note that weight-related health conditions are closely correlated with moving away from traditional foods to purchased foods



Often the people who captained subsistence hunting parties were also commercial fishers

When they sold their fishing permits, often no one in their families had the equipment required to fish for subsistence

Many people could no longer access traditional foods



As people turn to stores for their food, this leads to the loss of language, since people have fewer occasions where they draw upon these skills











Metro Nashville — 14 Counties














U.S. Youth Who are Overweight Percent by Age


